

BYLAWS OF PRINTING INDUSTRIES CREDIT UNION

ARTICLE I - NAME

SECTION 100. NAME. The name of this credit union shall be Printing Industries Credit Union.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSES

SECTION 200. GENERAL PURPOSE. The purpose of this credit union is to engage in credit union business and any other lawful activities which are not prohibited to a credit union by applicable laws and regulations.

SECTION 201. SPECIFIC PURPOSES. To achieve the general purpose, this credit union has the following purposes:

- (A) To promote thrift, honesty, integrity and the spirit of service among its members;
- (B) To receive money for certificates for funds or promissory notes, to receive from members money for the purchase of regular and special shares;
- (C) To make loans to its members at reasonable rates of interest;
- (D) To make loans to other credit unions;
- (E) To borrow money from any source in an amount not to exceed that permitted by the California Credit Union Law;
- (F) To associate and cooperate with other credit unions; and
- (G) To provide services to members to achieve the general purpose stated in SECTION 200.

ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

SECTION 300. QUALIFICATIONS. The field of membership shall be limited to those having the following common bond:

Eligible firms are those that specialize in the areas of printing and publishing, multi-media services, advertising and design, reprographics, quick printing and their related support industries, their employees, and members of their immediate families; other credit unions organized under either federal or state law, employees of this credit union, and members of their immediate families.

"Members of their immediate families" shall include: Grandparents, parents, husband, wife, domestic partner, children, foster children, adopted children, step children, brothers, sisters, aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, grandchildren, foster grandchildren, adopted grandchildren, step grandchildren, daughters-in-law, sons-in-law, brothers-in-law, sisters-in-law, mothers-in-law and fathers-in-law.
